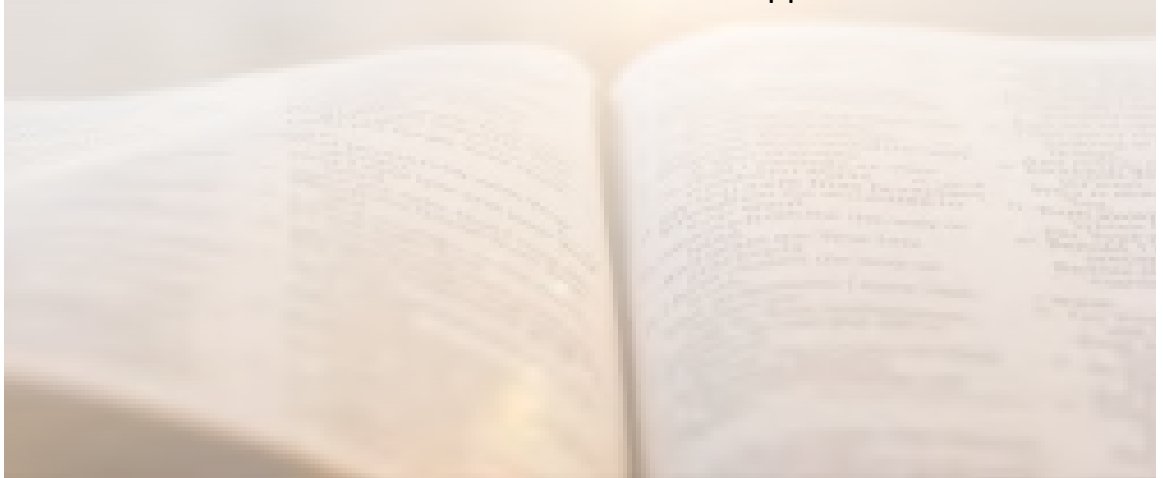

Acts 3:1-10 (NIV)

¹One day Peter and John were going up to the temple at the time of prayer— at three in the afternoon. ²Now a man who was lame from birth was being carried to the temple gate called Beautiful, where he was put every day to beg from those going into the temple courts. ³When he saw Peter and John about to enter, he asked them for money. ⁴Peter looked straight at him, as did John. Then Peter said, “Look at us!” ⁵So the man gave them his attention, expecting to get something from them.

⁶Then Peter said, “Silver or gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you. Imani Village Green Health Advocate

Basic Functions: Trinity United Church of Christ, Imani Village, Imani Works!, The Nature Conservancy, Advocate Health Care, the University of Illinois at Chicago, The Morton Arboretum, and the U.S. Forest Service have established a program that prepares emerging professionals for a career in urban conservation or community health, with a special focus on the skills needed to transform communities into healthier places to live. We are seeking eight individuals to form a team of Imani Village “Green Health Advocates” (IGHA) who will be responsible for promoting the health of people and nature in Chicago’s South Side.

We are seeking 4 individuals to be “**conservation health advocates**” who will: 1) Evaluate the health of natural resources (e.g., trees, greenspaces) of Chicago’s South Side; 2) Examine inequities in community access to natural resources; 3) Develop and implement a plan for equitable access to nature in target neighborhoods within Chicago’s South Side, and 4) Educate the community on their role in protecting nature to improve human health

We are seeking 4 individuals to be “**community health advocates**” who will: 1) Conduct patient assessments through interviews and other means; 2) Promote the health services of Advocate’s Trinity Hospital and Advocate Medical Group at Imani Village; 3) Conduct a community health assessment, addressing the social needs for Chicago’s South Side, and 4) Educate the community on their role in protecting nature to improve human health.


