
Mark 8:22-25 (NLT)

Guest Preacher





Gibson served as the Senior Pastor of The Place of the Outpouring @ Olivet Fellowship in Memphis, Tennessee.

Dr. Gibson, affectionately called "Pastor Geno" is an Albertina Walker Excellence in Gospel Music Scholarship Winner and served as the Minister of Music for the

Mission of Faith Baptist Church in Chicago, under his late father, Rev. Eugene Gibson, Sr. and at the New Faith Baptist Church in Matteson, Illinois, under the Pastorates of Drs. Frank Thomas and Trunell Felder. He also served as the Men's/Outreach Pastor at the Mississippi Boulevard Christian Church in Memphis, Tennessee with his mentor, Rev. Dr. Frank Anthony Thomas.

Pastor Geno holds a Bachelor of Theology; a Master of Arts in Religion/Urban Ministries; and a Doctorate of Ministry. He is an Adjunct Professor in the Preaching and Worship Department at both McCormick Theological Seminary in Chicago and Memphis Theological Seminary and has been a visiting professor at United Theological in Dayton Ohio and Christian Theological Seminary in Indiana. He is currently a student member of the Jubilee 50 Cohort of the prestigious PhD Program in African-American Preaching and Sacred Rhetoric at Christian Theological Seminary in Indianapolis, Indiana. He is also a 2012 inductee into the Martin Luther King, Jr. Board of Preachers of Morehouse College.

Rev. Geno is the proud husband of Shakitha Shanese Boone. Together, they share 4 amazing children, Trinity Essence, Taylor Emani, Jaden Christopher, and Kyndall Elise. He is a member of the Memphis Alumni Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Incorporated.






SecureGive provides mobile giving access from within the Trinity UCC Mobile App. Download the mobile app from the Apple App Store or Google Play.






